INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION (IJSCE)

The IJSCE examinations for students in grade nine (9) will commence on 10th June 2024 and end on the 21st instant. It is an examination based on the broad-based Key Stage 3 syllabus that assesses students in 15 core and one or two optional subjects. The best student overall with an A* in at least 10 core subjects (Mathematics, English and Science inclusive) and 4 A's will be offered a 50% scholarship (on tuition) for the entire duration of their senior high school tenure. We would like to remind you that we operate a dual curricular system – the Regional curriculum (WAEC) and the Cambridge International curriculum. Parents may opt for either stream from 10th Grade.
